### Program Manual for Participating Countries

#### I. Summary

##### 1. Features of GITC 2020

- Due to COVID-19 outbreak, GITC will be held through online platform, 'Zoom' in a loaded schedule.
- The Structure and contents of GITC has been changed in accordance with a online-based competition.

(1) No limit on place: The place of competition can be chosen freely and there are two types of participation.

▶ **On-site Participation (Gathering)**

- Participants should take part in a competition by gathering in a certain place.
- The whole competition will be monitored through 'Zoom' platform by the Secretariat.
- The financial support will be provided for group participations.  
\* Ref. p. 00 Principles of financial support

▶ **Off-site Participation (Non-gathering)**

- Participants take part in a competition in any comfortable places (even at home, school, café, etc).
- No Monitoring is required. But participants should keep the time of competition.
- There will be difference of prize money between individual and group presentation.  
\* Ref. p. 00 Principles of financial support

(2) **No limit on equipment**

- No restriction in using any type of equipment: mobile phone, laptop, desktop and etc.
- But for using OS, software and software for people with visual impairment, please refer to rules of event.

### (3) No limit on participation

- 1 person can participate in more than 1 event.
- There are 5 events in total: eLifeMap Challenge, eTool\_Excel Challenge, eTool\_Powerpoint Challenge, eContents Challenge, eCreative Challenge
- In previous GITC, there was a limit in participation for eTool Challenge depending on having disabilities with visual impairment. But in 2020 GITC, participants can take part in both events of eTool Challenge (Excel and PowerPoint) regardless of the types of disability.
- In eContents and eCreative Challenge which used to be based on group participation, participants can take part in a form of either alone or a group consisting of 2~4 members.

### (4) No limit on number of participants

- There is no limit on the numbers of participants in each country.
- The time of competition will be held at 14:00, Jan 26<sup>th</sup> (Republic of Korea time, GMT+9), having considered the average time difference of 4 hours for all participating countries.
- While eLifeMap, eTool Excel and Powerpoint Challenge will be held during official competition schedule (Jan 26<sup>th</sup> ~ 27<sup>th</sup> 2021), eContents and eCreative Challenge will be held before official competition schedule (Jan 20<sup>th</sup> ~ 25<sup>th</sup> 2021).

- Mode of Operating Competition: Online-based competition through 'Zoom'

▶ **Participants** can take part in competitions, as follows

- (1) On-site participation in certain places prepared by each country
- (2) Off-site participation in a preferred place
- (3) mixed form of (1) and (2)

### 3. Registration

#### 1) Eligibility of youth with disabilities

- ① Age: 14~22 years old
- ② Types of Disabilities: no restriction in types of disabilities from GITC 2020
  - ▶ **Individual participation:** Visual, Hearing, Intellectual, Physical disabilities and all other types
  - ▶ **Group participation:** maximum 4 members in a group(single member is allowed), no restriction in types of disabilities
- ③ **Number of participants:** no restriction
- ④ **Join as a member:** Applications for all types of participation can be made only after obtain the membership

#### 2) Eligibility and Roles of Chaperone

##### ① Eligibility of Chaperone

- Government officials related to IT and social welfare, Experts, NGO professionals in the field of persons with disabilities
- Ability to manage participant from homeland
- Decent knowledge and sound understanding on GITC

### ② Roles of Chaperone

- To take charge in the process of recruiting and selecting appropriate participants
- Submit application forms between Nov. 6<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020
- To facilitate participants and operation of the competitions (Jan 20<sup>th</sup> ~ 27<sup>th</sup>, 2021)
- To submit the Evaluation of the implementation of the Hanoi Declaration & Capacity Building of Youth with Disabilities by Nov. 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020

### ③ Membership acquirement

- Chaperone also needs to obtain the membership prior to apply

### ④ Registration of a representative Chaperone

- More than one chaperone can apply, but a representative should be decided and registered during the application process
- The authority will be given to the representative only

### 6. Financial Support for Participating Countries

#### 1) Principle for financial support

- ① The chaperones have to reserve a place that is appropriate for 2020 GITC competition.

#### 2) Range of financial support for facilitating the competence

- ① Financial support will be offered to only least-developed and lower middle-income countries, and it will be supported differently.
- ② Financial support is limited to youth with disabilities who attend the on-site Challenge and **being monitored by GITC Secretariat**. Therefore, it will not be given to off-site participants, participating from individually decided places.
- ③ Also, Financial support will be provided only for groups that consists of at least 20 participants. Due to the limited budget, the support can be offered maximum 30 participants. However, additional participation more than 30 participants is possible with each country's self-finance

#### 3) Range of financial support for participation

- ① 10 USD (\$10) will be offered to all youth participants (including individual and group participations) apart from financial support for operating expenses explained above.
- ② 'Youth participant' stands for a youth with disabilities who actually participates in each Challenge according to the event schedule and submit his/her answer sheet. In the case

#### eLifeMap Challenge

---

##### 1. Overview

- Description

Instead of a simple question based on internet surfing, the participants will search and make use of the useful information that are exciting and helpful in real life of youth with disabilities. Apart from simple text search, the participant will develop ability to access information in multimedia society by improving advanced searching skill such as image searching.

- Type of participation: Individual
- Type of disability: No restriction in type of disability (all types of disabilities)  
Level of assignment will be differed for participants with developmental disability
- Time: 50 mins for 10 questions (70 mins for screen reader user)
- Type of tests
  - Browsing skills for useful information or on searching method that can be easily used in a daily life
  - Utilizing portal services and searching for social issue and important figures
  - Short answer questions

##### 2. Environment and Operation

- Place and equipment
  - No restriction on place for participation. Both on-site participation(group participation and being monitored through Zoom) and off-site participation(individuals) in any comfortable places such as home, school, café are allowed (Off-site/individual participation is not monitored and scale of prize is difference)
  - No restriction in equipment, mobile phone, laptop, desktop computer can be used.
  - Software: OS over Windows 7 and four types of browser (use freely among Internet Explorer 10, Mozilla Firefox, Safari, Chrome)
  - Software for participants with visual impairment: Jaws

  - 2<sup>nd</sup> priority: Younger age

  - After 3 times of warning are given
  - When participants did not log on their real name on Zoom
  - When used medium that can share information with others, including email, facebook and etc.
  - When used other external storage device such as USB memory

#### 1. Overview

##### 1) Description

- This Challenge tests the ability in use of office programs and multimedia including writing, revising and editing document with speed and accuracy

##### 2) Type of participation: Individual

##### 3) Type of disability: All types of disability

- There is no restriction on type of disabilities.
- Youth with visual impairment can attend eTool Challenge\_Powerpoint
- Also, youth without visual impairment can attend eTool Challenge\_Excel, unlike before

##### 4) Time: 50 mins for 10 questions (70 mins for screen reader user)

##### 5) Types of test

- Excel: Skills in use of the functions in Excel, and ability on data calculation in accordance with conditions in written data sheet in the form of the multiple choice questions
- Powerpoint: Ability to make PPT slides in Powerpoint

#### 2. Environment and Operation

##### 1) Place and equipment

- No restriction on place for participation. Both on-site participation(group participation and being monitored through Zoom) and off-site participation(individuals) in any comfortable places such as home, school, café are allowed (Off-site/individual participation is not monitored and scale of prize is difference)
- No restriction in equipment, mobile phone, laptop, desktop computer can be used.
- Software
  - Powerpoint: OS over Windows 7 and Windows MS Office 2010
  - Excel: PDF viewer such as web browser, Adobe Acrobat Reader DC, instead of Excel program
- Software for participants with visual impairment: Jaws and NVDA

### 3) Evaluation

- Evaluation and Criteria
  - It is mandatory to submit answer in English and if not, no scores will be given
  - Check whether instructions are well carried out
  - Check whether answer is accurately written
  - For multiple choice questions, automatic scoring system in the platform will be used
- Priority for even scores
  - 1<sup>st</sup> priority: Level of disabilities
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> place: Younger age

### 3) Penalty for cheating: only for participants monitored through Zoom

- Warning
  - Disturbing other participants
  - Leaving the place without permission
- Disqualification
  - After 3 times of warning are given
  - When participants did not log on their real name on Zoom
  - When used medium that can share information with others, including email, facebook and etc.
  - When used other external storage device such as USB memory

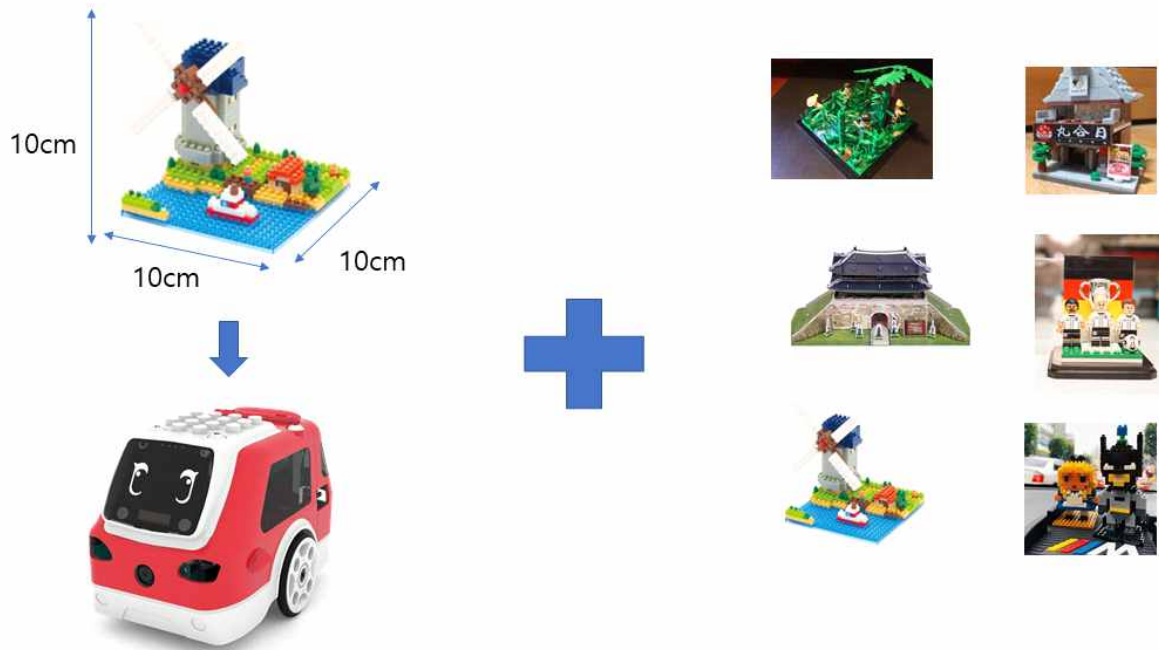

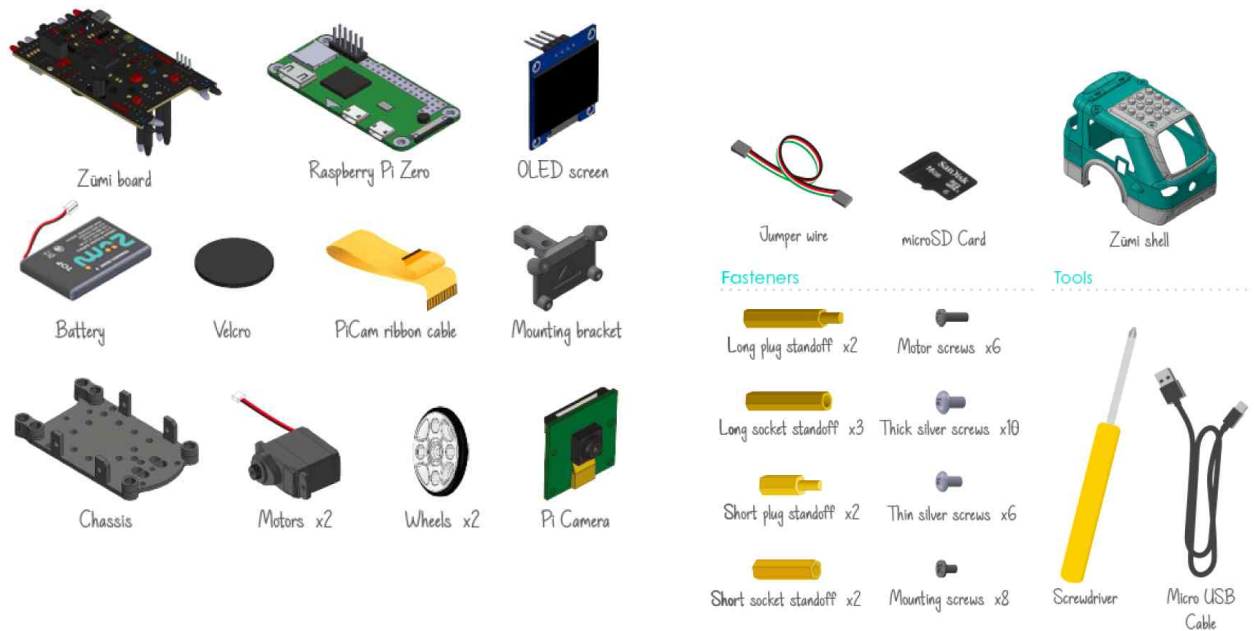

3) Testing Ground for Exercise : 96 x 96 cm

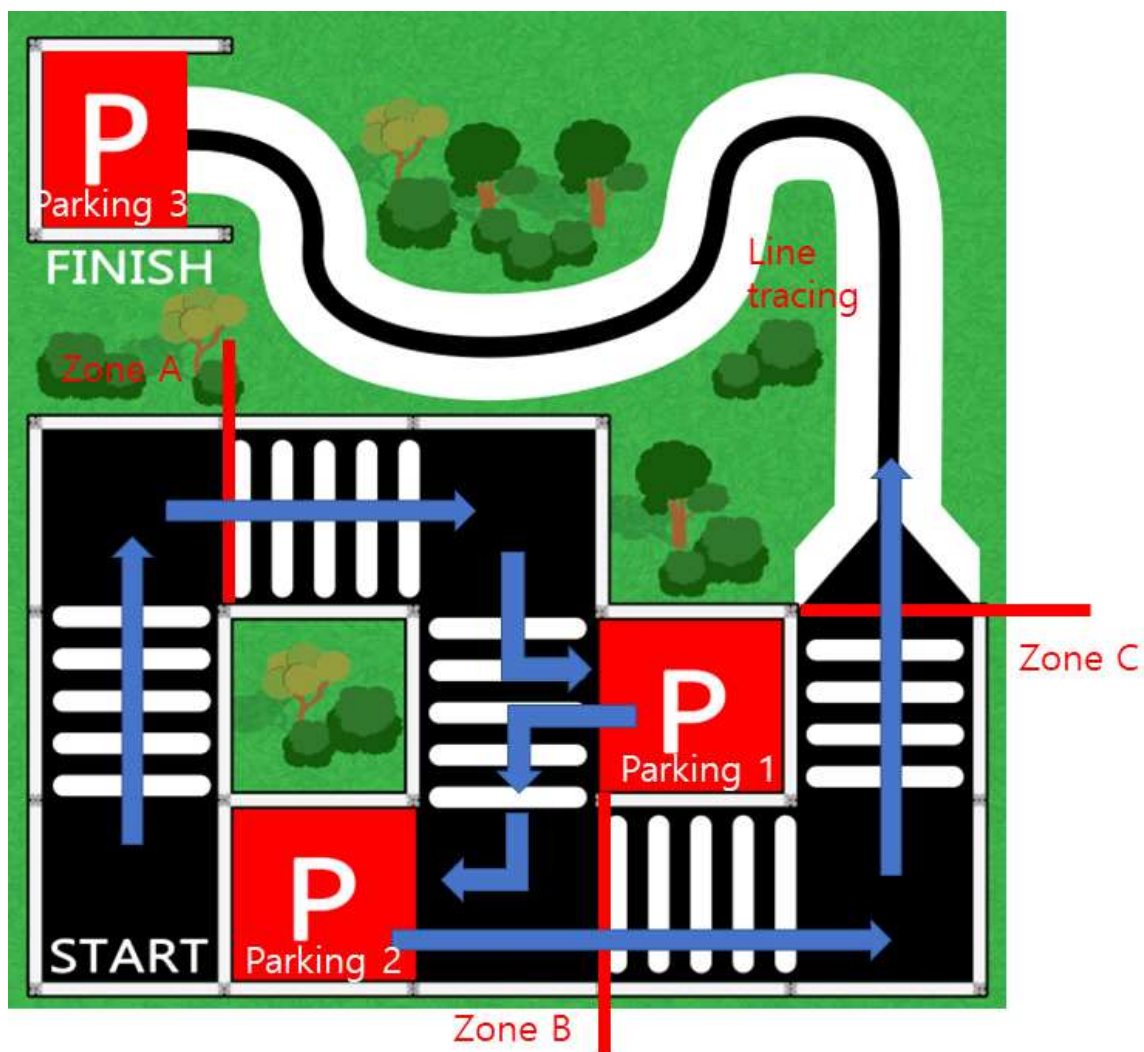
○ The miniature car should be at the starting point when the competition begins
